


# Trolley Assembly Instruction

for Wildcat 9000 Pizza Oven Trolley

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## Components

#### **Carton Contents**

1 x LHS Top Panel



4 x Cross Braces



1 x RHS Top Panel



4 x Triangular Braces



1 x LHS Bottom Panel



**4 x** 50mm Square Tube Legs



1 x RHS Bottom Panel



4 x Lockable Castors



1 x Front Top Panel (With Badge)



**64 x** 6mm Black Pan Head Screws



1 x Rear Top Panel



**4 x** 3/8 " X 1 1/2" Hex Bolts



1 x Front Bottom Panel



**4 x** 3/8" Washers



1 x Rear Bottom Panel



#### **Tools Required:**

Phillips Head Screwdriver, Cordless drill with phillips head screwdriver bit. Ring spanners or 2 adjustable spanners (Shifters)

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


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## **Trolley Assembling Step.1**

Step (1) - Unload all of the components and assemble the 'RHS' + 'LHS' bottom panels to the legs, ensure the nutserts on the legs are facing outwards and that the nutserts on the panels (both RHS + LHS) are facing up.

Using the 6mm black pan head screws, keeping them loose (only finger tight.)



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




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## **Trolley Assembling Step.2**

Step (2) - Attach the **Front Bottom** panel to the **LHS+RHS** and then attach the **Rear Bottom** panel to the **LHS+RHS**.




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## **Trolley Assembling Step.3**

Step (3) - Attach all four Cross Braces to both LHS TOP panel and RHS TOP panel. Remember to keep all 6mm black pan head screws fingertight.




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## **Trolley Assembling Step.4**

Step (4) - Now attach the **Front Top** panel (with the WILDCAT badge) and the **Rear Top** panel to the **RHS+LHS Top** panels. Please note, only use the 6mm screws on the **Front Top** panel and keep them only fingertight. **DO NOT** use screws on the **Rear Top** panel yet. Just simply sit the Rear Top panel on the frame.




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## **Trolley Assembling Step.5**

Step (5) - Place the frame that you have just assembled over the four legs of the trolley. Screw the frame into the leg nutserts and keep them only fingertight.



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


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# **Trolley Assembling Step.6**

Step (6) - It's time to install the **Triangular Braces.** (x4)

Place them out along the four legs and use 6mm black pan head screws.



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


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## Trolley Assembling Step.7 & 8

Step (7) - Tighten all the screws on the trolley

Step (8) - Flip the trolley upside down (180°)
You may need a second person to assist at this stage.
Please lay the trolley on something soft after you flip it over.



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## **Trolley Assembling Step.9**

Step (9) - Attach all four castors to the legs.

**A.** Fit the castor brackets to each corner as shown. Make sure the large washer is in place over the captive nut. Tighten the 3/8" bolt fully before the castor wheel is fitted.

Attach the Castor bracket with the 3/8" bolt provided.



**B.** Fit each castor wheel to the brackets.



**C.** Now the caster units are ready to roll. You can now stand trolley back up right.



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




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## **Trolley Assembling Step.10**

Step (10) - Place the **Galvanized Metal** sheet on the top of the trolley then cover it with the **Cement sheet**.



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


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## **Trolley Assembling Step.11**

Step (11) - Place the Wildcat 9000 oven on top of the trolley, remove stainless steel plastic protector before first firing.

\*The side tables shown in the drawing are optional products.



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## Maintenance & Safe Operation

The heavy duty powder coated finish on your Wildcat Pizza Oven Trolley should require no more than the occasional wipe with a damp cloth to keep it looking good. Heavier food stains can be safely removed with a non abrasive proprietry household cleaner. Occasionaly it may be necessary to re-tighten the screws.

#### **SAFETY WARNING:**

With a Wildcat Pizza Oven fitted, the oven/trolley combination is very heavy and will require a minimum of 2 adults to move it safely on flat smooth surfaces only.

- *Do not* attempt to move the oven/trolley combination on uneven ground.
- Never attempt to move the oven/trolley whilst there is an active fire in the oven, or while hot.
- Ensure all castors are locked before using the oven.
- *Do not* operate the oven on uneven or sloping ground.

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
